Mixed Media Bat Silhouette

Ages: 5-12

Materials: pencil masking tape

watercolor paper (cardstock is an option for paper circle stencil)

watercolor paint

acrylic paint (black and white)

Which art principle(s) or technique(s) does this lesson teach?

- Light and Shadow
- Mixed Media
- Edges

Instructions for teacher:

- 1. Place a watercolor paper circle stencil on the watercolor paper and trace it with a pencil.
- 2. Remove the stencil and watercolor paint inside the moon using extra water.
- 3. Dry watercolor paper and place stencil back over the moon (secure with tape wad).
- 4. Paint the entire paper with black acrylic and splatter white acrylic paint to make stars.
- 5. Remove the stencil and paint the bat and trees (may outline with pencil first and/or use permanent marker to fill in).
