**Simple Autum Landscape** 

**Ages**: 5-12

Materials: Pencil, Sharpie, Watercolor, brushes, water, paper towels.

## Which art principle(s) or technique(s) does this lesson teach?

- Depth
- Foreground/ Middle Ground/ Background
- Overlapping
- Color
- Charging
- Shapes

## Instructions for teacher:

- 1. <u>Draw the landscape</u> with a pencil, start with the hills and trees and bushes closest to you and then move up the page, to the next hill and the next etc..
- 2. <u>Ways to achieve space</u> Overlapping, scale of repeated items getting smaller in background, Height on page, going off edge of paper etc.
- 3. Outline your drawing with sharpie
- 4. Control the water flow Use a water wash on the current shape and then add color, repeat! Work one shape at a time.
- 5. Variations in color the middle hill is bule green and the back hill is yellow green etc.
- 6. Do all the greens and cool colors first and then go back and do your warm colors so they don't run together
- 7. <u>Charging</u> is a wet-on-wet technique where you drop one wet color into another wet color. Its great way to do the leaves in the trees and bushes.
