Ceramic Birdhouse

Ages: 9-12

Materials

• White earthenware clay, rolling pins, clay boards, clay tools for carving, assorted glazes, wet sponges, can or bottle to act as a form

Art Techniques

- Slab clay construction
- Score and slip clay construction
- Sculpture
- Clay

Art Principles

- Balance
- Texture
- Pattern/ Repetition

Instructions

- 1. Roll slab of clay large enough to wrap around a soda can make a cylinder.
- 2. Roll another slab to attach to bottom of cylinder. Trim to fit.
- 3. Roll a slab and cut to a circle slightly larger than the circumference of cylinder
- 4. Create a shallow cone with the circle for top of birdhouse.
- 5. Use slip and score technique to add details (branches, leaves etc.) to birdhouse and lid.
- 6. Remove can from birdhouse when it is firm enough to stand on own (not overnight!)
- 7. Use carving tools to add texture and pattern to birdhouse.
- 8. Cut a hole for bird and perch when clay is leather hard.
- 9. Bisque fire to 04.
- 10. Glaze and refire at 06.
