Wicked Witch Elphaba in pastel

Ages: 5-12

Materials:

- Chalk Pastels
- Pencil
- Black or Toned Paper
- Black Charcoal Pencil
- White Charcoal Pencil

Art Techniques

- Blending
- Portrait
- Emotions

Art Principles

- Figure/ Anatomy
- Positive and Negative Space
- Emphasis
- Contrast
- Asymmetry
- Balance

Instructions:

- 1. Lightly sketch in pencil Elphaba's face, emphasizing proportion, composition, and placement of features (eyes, nose, lips). For younger students you can use transfer paper.
- 2. Begin applying light layers of color green tones for skin, black/dark purple/brown for the hat.
- 3. Block in the eyes, lips, and key shadow shapes.
- 4. Blend using fingers or tools, maintaining edge control and color richness.
- 5. Use a charcoal pencil to refine details and add eyelashes.
- 6. Use a white charcoal pencil or pastel and add highlights
