Lesson Plan & Artwork Submission Agreement

Lesson Plan Submissions must meet these criteria:

- The artwork must be original artwork created by the artist themself.
- The artwork cannot be the same as another existing artwork or lesson plan already created for Cordovan Art School.
- The artwork must show artistic competence, skill, and craftsmanship.
- The photo of the artwork must be high-quality (good lighting/ cropped/ straight, not crooked, etc.)
- The artist must fill out all information below, including the section where they write simple, clear step-by-step instructions.

Compensation

• The artist will receive \$15 per accepted lesson plan submission. A lesson plan will be accepted if it meets all criteria listed above.

Contract between Cordovan Art School and Artist

1. Ownership and Rights

As the artist, I retain ownership of the original artwork, but I waive any claims for additional compensation beyond the agreed \$15 per submission.

I hereby grant Cordovan Art School a non-exclusive, perpetual, worldwide, royalty-free license to use, reproduce, adapt, display, publish, and distribute the submitted artwork and lesson plans for any purpose, including but not limited to educational use, marketing, publication, or resale. Cordovan Art School may modify or adapt the artwork or lesson plans as needed to suit its purposes.

2. Originality

I affirm that the submitted lesson plans and artwork are original creations and do not infringe upon the copyrights or rights of any other individual or entity.

3. Independent Contractor Status

I agree that nothing in this Agreement shall be construed to create a partnership, joint venture, or employment relationship. I am acting as an independent contractor.
