Snowy Pines

Ages: 5-7

Materials

- Canvas, acrylics (black and white), paintbrushes, construction paper (white), scissors, watercolor paper, hot glue, watercolor paint (green), paper towel, pencil and eraser

Art Techniques

- Mixed Media
- Splatter Painting
- Landscape Painting

Art Principles

- Perspective
- Movement/ Rhythm
- Pattern/ Repetition

Instructions

1. Acrylic paint the entire canvas black. Splatter paint white stars in the sky.
2. Take several pieces of white construction paper and draw wavy lines at different heights. Cut out using scissors.
3. Sketch triangles for trees on watercolor paper. Cut them out using scissors. Watercolor paint trees green and dry. Optional: You can paint a pattern on the trees.
4. Place trees and mountains in desired composition and hot glue into place.
