Frankenstein Cats

Ages: 5-12

Materials

• Canvas, acrylics, paintbrushes, white pastel pencil, paper towel, fine-tip permanent marker

Art Techniques

- Animal Portraiture
- Abstract Painting
- Dotting

Art Principles

- Warm and Cool Colors
- Movement/ Rhythm
- Pattern/ Repetition

Instructions

- 1. Paint your background first: Paint a yellow circle for your moon. Blend in yellow ochre toward edge of circle. Then paint blue around the moon, then a darker shade of blue closer to the edge of the canvas.
- 2. Let your background dry completely.
- 3. Draw your cats, and the patterns inside the cats using a white pastel pencil. Wipe away any mistakes with a damp paper towel.
- 4. Outline each section using fine-tip permanent marker.
- 5. Paint one cat warm colors and the other cat cool colors. Each section of the cat should be a different hue or shade.
- 6. Use back end of paintbrush to poke yellow and white dots in sky.
- 7. Clean up black outlines by adding final lines and details on top.
