Cat in a Witch Hat

Ages: 5-12

Materials

Watercolor paper, color pencils, oil pastels, watercolor paint, sharpie, pencil

Art Techniques

- Blending with color pencil
- Oil pastel resist
- Texture
- Mixed media

Art Principles

- Balance
- Pattern/ Repetition

Instructions

- 1. Start by sketching the hat, add the buckle detail and a cat face peeking from the bottom. Only half of the cat's face should be showing.
- 2. Use a dark <u>color pencil</u> for the outer edges of the hat then gradually use lighter colors to blend into the center. Add pattern details with <u>white oil pastel</u> on the hat if desired. Color the buckle strap with yellow or another bright color and add a gold buckle. Color in the cat's face, eyes and nose.
- 3. Use oil pastel to create stars in the background.
- 4. Paint the background with watercolor wash. The stars will resist the watercolor paint.
