Bright Koala

Ages: 5-12

Materials

 Canvas, acrylics, paintbrushes, watercolor paper, colored pencils, pastels (optional), pencil, permanent marker, hot glue gun, paper towel, scissors

Art Techniques

- Layering
- Blending
- Mixed Media
- Contour lines
- Character Illustration

Art Principles

- Emphasis
- Balance

Instructions

- 1. Paint canvas using blue & white acrylic paint, keeping the strokes horizontal. Dry.
- 2. Paint branch using different shades of brown acrylic paint. Dry.
- 3. Paint leaves using various shades of green acrylic paint. Make sure to overlap branch. Let dry.
- 4. Lightly sketch out koala on watercolor paper w/ pencil, then trace sketch w/ permanent marker, filling in eyes, nose, hands & feet.
- 5. Wet the sketch w/ water & brush, have student randomly fill in sketch w/ bright colors of their choice. Blend the colors together, & show different techniques of blending, including adding splatters, blotting, & making areas darker in color. Dry.
- 6. Do Koala details w/ white paint markers (or pastels). Add highlights to eyes/nose, & fur texture.
- 7. Cut out koala sketch w/ scissors & hot glue directly onto painted canvas.
