# Patterns & Brushstrokes

**Ages**: 5-12

#### **Materials**

White cardstock, Markers, black fine marker, scissors, pencil

## **Art Techniques**

- Line Art
- Patterns
- Color Blending
- Simple Collage

## **Art Principles/ Elements**

- Line
- Pattern/Repetition
- Color
- Balance
- Emphasis

#### Instructions

- 1. Use your pencil to draw a large paintbrush and a long, wavy paint stroke on a separate piece of paper.
- 2. Color the paintbrush handle brown, the metal yellow, and then color the wavy stroke in rainbow order (red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple).
- 3. Cut out your colored paintbrush and rainbow paint stroke carefully with scissors.
- 4. On a new piece of white paper, use your pencil to divide it into different sections and then draw a unique black line pattern in each section.
- 5. Glue your cut-out rainbow paint stroke and paintbrush onto the patterned paper to make it appear as if the brush is painting the rainbow.
