Kandinsky Circles

Ages: 5-12

Materials

- Watercolor paper, watercolor paints, sharpie, pencil, paintbrush

Art Techniques

- Watercolor
- Shapes
- Grid making
- Measuring

Art Principles

- Symmetry
- Balance
- Pattern/ Repetition

Instructions

1. Use a ruler to divide your 9 by 12 watercolor paper into a 4 by 3 square grid with the squares being roughly the same size.
2. Trace all the squares with a sharpie.
3. Draw 3 circles in each square. The circles should be within each other in the order of big, medium and small.
4. Paint each square/circle set being sure not to use the same color twice in a single square.
